KNOW ALL PERSONS HEREBY PRESENT: That ,
doing business as a under the laws of the State
or Providence of residing or having a principal place of
business at
hereby constitutes and appoints Bay Brokerage Inc., its officers, employees and/or specifically authorized
agents, to act for and on its behalf as a true and lawful agent and attorney of the grantor for and in the
name, place and stead of said grantor, from this date, in the United States (the "Territory") either in writing,
electronically, or by other authorized means, to:

Make, endorse, sign, declare, or swear to any Customs entry, withdrawal, declaration, certificate, bill of lading, carnet, shipper's export declaration, commercial invoice, insurance certificate, draft or any other documents required by law or regulation in connection with the importation, exportation or transportation of any merchandise in or through the Customs territory, shipped or consigned by or to said grantor;

Perform any act or condition which may be required by law or regulation of the Department of Commerce, Department of the Treasury or any other governmental agency in connection with such merchandise deliverable to or from said grantor; to receive or ship any merchandise;

Make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title; make entry or collect drawback; and to make, sign, declare, or swear to any statement or certificate required by law or regulation for drawback purposes, regardless of whether such document is intended for filing with US Customs & Border Protection;

Sign, seal, and deliver for and as the act of said grantor any bond required by law or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of imported merchandise or merchandise exported with or without benefit of drawback or in connection with the entry, clearance, lading, unlading or navigation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor, and any and all bonds which may be voluntarily given and accepted under applicable laws and regulations, consignee's and owner's declarations provided for in section 485, Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, or affidavits or statements in connection with the entry of merchandise;

Sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with the entering, clearing, lading, unlading, or operation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor;

Authorize other Customs Brokers duly licensed within the Territory to act as grantor's agent; to receive, endorse and collect checks issued for Customs duty refunds in grantor's name drawn on the Treasurer of the United States; if the grantor is a nonresident of the Territory, to accept service of process on behalf of the grantor;

And generally to transact Customs business, including making, signing and filing of claims or protests under section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930, or pursuant to other laws of the territories, in which said grantor is or may be concerned or interested and which may properly be transacted or performed by an agent and attorney;

Giving to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said grantor could do if present and acting, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents;

This power of attorney is to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given to and received by the District Director of U S Customs & Border Protection and Bay Brokerage, Inc. (If the donor of this power of attorney is a partnership, the said power shall in no case have any force or effect in the Territory after the expiration of two (2) years from the date of its execution);

Appointment as Forwarding Agent: Grantor authorizes Bay Brokerage Inc., Inc. to act within the Territory as lawful agent and sign or endorse export documents (i.e., commercial invoices, bills of lading, insurance certificates, drafts and any other document), necessary for the completion of an export on Grantor's behalf as may be required under law and regulation in the Territory and to appoint Forwarding Agents on Grantor's behalf. Grantor authorizes Bay Brokerage, Inc. to endorse or negotiate any draft, check, or warrant drawn to the order of the Grantor in connection with the exportation of any commodity shipped, consigned or forwarded by the Grantor.

By executing this Power of Attorney, we confirm our understanding that as Importer of Record for transactions cleared through U.S. Customs & Border Protection by Bay Brokerage, Inc. ("Bay"), all the billing concerning our shipments into the United States will be done through the forwarder, and will include the brokerage, duties, and bond charges as well as any forwarding and transportation charges associated with those shipments. The charges may not reflect the actual charges billed to Diversified Vehicle Services (DVS) by Bay. With reference to 19 CFR 111.24, relating to the confidentiality of records, we herewith authorize Bay to transmit to forwarder any pertinent entry-related records resulting from the clearance of our shipments by Bay through U.S. Customs. Pursuant to 19 CFR 111.36, concerning relations with unlicensed persons, we waive the right to receive directly from Bay either a copy of their bill for services or a copy of the entry.

All shipments are handled pursuant to the Terms and Conditions of Service and the forwarder applicable House Ocean Bills of Lading and Air Waybills. The said Terms are incorporated herein and made part of this Agreement and shall be binding upon the Customer.

Customs powers of attorney or residents (including resident corporations) shall be without power of substitution except for the purpose of executing shipper's export declarations. However, a power of attorney executed in favor of a licensed Customs broker may specify that the power of attorney is granted to the Customs broker to act through any of its licensed officers or any employee specifically authorized to act for such Customs broker by power of attorney.

If you are the importer of record, payment to the broker will not relieve you of liability for U.S. Customs charges (duties, taxes or other debts owed Customs) in the event the charges are not paid by the broker. Therefore, if you pay by check, Customs charges may be paid with a separate check payable to the "U.S. Customs & Border Protection" which shall be delivered to Customs by the broker. Importers who wish to utilize this procedure must contact our office in advance to arrange timely receipt of duty checks.
